Mr. Paffendorf mentioned that with the County working towards single stream recycling, perhaps our gray cans won't be big enough. Mayor Boyle explained that the public works supervisor is working on a new plan.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

Mr. Budesá thanked the people who voted. The Christmas Tree lighting is December 6 at 4 PM.

Mr. Abatamarco thanked everyone for voting. Mrs. Sutter ran a spirited campaign, discussing issues not politics.
