

RESOLUTION 09-93

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed the trash and recycling ordinances, and

WHEREAS, Pine Beach Code Chapter 96-2 (D) specifies that one additional trash container may be leased by residents who qualify at a fee to be established by resolution of the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Pine Beach, County of Ocean, State of new Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Council hereby establishes the following fee to acquire an additional trash container effective January 1, 2010:
 - (a) If a qualified homeowner requests an additional trash container it shall be leased for a non-refundable fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
 - (b) On January 1 of each succeeding year, the fee of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be assessed for continued use of the second can. If the fee is not paid by January 30, the second can will be removed by the public works department.
 - (c) Each trash container will be allocated to a specific address.
 - (d) The trash container shall be returned to the Borough of Pine Beach at the time the homeowner sells the property.
2. Residents who qualify:
 - (a) Resident must comply with all recycling regulations
 - (b) There must be five or more people living in the home
 - (c) For special circumstances, the Mayor and Council will make determination of need.
3. The Municipal Clerk is instructed to notify every resident with a registered existing second can that the \$50.00 fee will be in effect January 1, 2010 and advising them to call to return the can if they no longer need it.
4. The Public Works Supervisor is authorized to remove the second can from homes that have a second can but are not registered or paid.
